

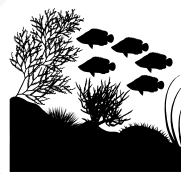


How To Record Data?

AT THE MOST BASIC LEVEL, WE ASK OUR VOLUNTEERS TO PERFORM SIX SIMPLE TASKS WHILE THEY GO ABOUT THEIR REGULAR DIVING ACTIVITIES. KNOWING THESE ACTIONS PRIOR TO YOUR DIVE WILL ENSURE THE DATA COLLECTED CAN BE EASILY UPLOADED TO THE PROJECT BASELINE DATABASE.



Take pictures of the underwater environment you're exploring



Keep the focus of the pictures on identifiable features – as opposed to their friends or their gear.



Make the pictures as reproducible as possible – the overall goal being to record change through time.



Record the location of the site they're documenting – using GPS, Google Earth, charts, etc.



Record the temperature and visibility too if practicable.
